



Uxbridge Downtown Flood Reduction Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (EA) NOTICE OF FILING OF ADDENDUM

PUBLIC NOTICE

The *Downtown Uxbridge Flood Reduction Environmental Study Report (ESR)* recommended replacing an existing culvert under Brock St. with new, larger twin culverts. The concept was considered approved through the Municipal Class EA process in 2012.

In 2015, the Township made changes to the recommended concept by extending the twin culverts along the full length of the current alignment - as detailed in a first Addendum to the ESR. The Township is now proposing to alter the dimensions and alignment of the twin culverts through a second Addendum. The details and rationale for the proposed changes to the recommended concept are described in this Addendum which is available for a 30 day public viewing period between **November 24** and **December 24, 2016** at:
