

2012 INTERIM TAX INFORMATION

The Taxes Payable on this 2012 Interim Tax Bill are due in two (2) instalments:
1st Instalment Due: February 29, 2012
2nd Instalment Due: April 30, 2012

This Interim Tax Bill is based on the 2012 assessed value as shown on your assessment notice and tax rates calculated to equal approximately 50% of your 2011 property taxes. Note a small adjustment shown as "To Equal 50% of 2011", may appear as a 'Special Charge' on your bill, in order to adjust your 2012 interim taxes to 50% of 2011 property taxes. The 2012 Final Tax Rates will not be finalized until the final budget requirements for the Ministry of Education, Region of Durham and the Township of Uxbridge, have been determined. It is expected that the Final 2012 Tax Bills will be issued the end of May or beginning of June 2012.

Late Payment

For non-payment of the interim levy on or before the respective due dates of each instalment, a penalty of one and one quarter percent (1 1/4%) shall be imposed on the first day of default and on the first day of each calendar month thereafter in which default continues. Failure to receive a Tax Notice does not exempt the taxpayer from late payment charges. The penalty/interest charges cannot be waived or reduced by the Tax Department for any reason.

Property Tax Receipt for Income Tax Returns

Taxpayers should retain their receipted Property Tax Bill for reference when completing the Ontario Tax Credit portion of their Income Tax Return. If a reprinted tax bill or receipt is required a fee of \$10.00 + HST will be charged.

Property Assessments

In 2008, the Municipal Property Assessment Corporation (MPAC) sent out assessment notices which reflected your current value assessment as at January 1, 2008. Any assessment increases were to be phased-in over a four year period. This tax bill is based on the 2012 assessed value (final year of the phase-in) that was shown on your original assessment notice. If you do not agree with this assessment, the deadline to file a 'Request for Reconsideration' with MPAC for the 2012 taxation year is April 2, 2012. If you have questions regarding your assessment, you can contact MPAC by telephone at 1-866-296-6722 or through their website www.mpac.ca. MPAC offers through their website, an online service called 'AboutMyProperty' that provides property taxpayers with convenient access to property assessment information, site information and recent sales information on their property and similar properties, free of charge.

2011 Vacancy Rebates

The deadline to file a Commercial/Industrial Vacancy Rebate application for the 2011 taxation year is February 28, 2012. The 'Vacancy Rebate Application Form' and the 'Vacancy Rebate Eligibility Criteria' are on our website at www.town.uxbridge.on.ca, under 'Departments', 'Treasury'.

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Notice from the Uxbridge By Law Department

Things to remember for the winter season:

1. Overnight parking is prohibited on Township roads and municipal parking lots from November 1st through April 1st, 2 am -7 am.
 2. Every owner or occupant must clear or cause to be cleared any slush, snow and ice from any sidewalk adjacent to any building or land with 24 hours of the accumulation of slush, snow and ice. This includes all buildings, occupied or not and vacant lands.
 3. An owner or occupant must clear or cause to be cleared the roof any building with an adjacent sidewalk of any slush, snow and ice within 24 hours of accumulation. This includes all buildings, occupied or not.
- Note: Failure to clear snow away from sidewalks within 24 hours of accumulation may result in the Township having the snow cleared and costs added to municipal taxes**
- Any methods used to remove slush, snow and ice can not cause damage to sidewalks.**
4. The Township of Uxbridge Snow Clearing By-law prohibits snow from being swept, shoveled, thrown, dropped or placed or cause to be swept, shoveled, thrown, dropped or placed onto a highway.
 5. Remember when you see snow start to fall make sure your vehicles are off the roadway to permit snow removal.

Notice from the Uxbridge Fire Department

All 2011 Burning Permits issued in 2011, expired December 31, 2011.

2012 Burning Permits may be obtained at the Municipal Office at 51 Toronto Street, South or the Fire Station at 17 Bascom Street during normal business hours, Monday to Friday, 8:30 am to 4:30 pm.

2012 Fees are:

\$25.00 for a Regular Permit
\$75.00 for an Oversize Permit
N/C for a Recreational Permit

All new Oversize Sites must be inspected by the Fire Department prior to issuance of an Oversize Permit.

2012 Dog Tags are available at the Town Hall, 51 Toronto Street South, Uxbridge, during normal office hours, and at the Animal Centre, 10:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m., or purchased from Pet Valu or Uxbridge Veterinary Clinic. Tags may be purchased by mail upon receipt of the Owner's Name, Mailing Address, Telephone Number, Breed and Sex of the dog. Every owner of a dog in the Township shall, on or before March 31st in any year, or upon becoming the owner of a dog after March 31st, register such dog with the licence issuer and procure a dog licence and dog tag at the following prescribed fees:

Neutered or spayed dogs: \$20.00 Non-fixed dogs: 1st dog - \$30.00, 2nd dog - \$35.00, 3rd Dog \$40.00

Maximum 2 dogs per household or maximum 3 dogs per household if you have 10 or more acres: Proof of Neutered or Spayed dogs must be shown. The running at large of dogs within the Township of Uxbridge is prohibited. The Uxbridge-Seugog Animal Centre is located in Seugog Township at 1360 Reach Street/Durham Road No. 8.
