WINTER REMINDERS

OVERNIGHT PARKING

Please be advised that By-law 89-52 as amended prohibits overnight parking from November 1 until April 1 between the hours of 2 am and 7 am on roadways and Municipal lots within the Township of Uxbridge.

SNOW REMOVAL OBSTRUCTION

Did you know that in accordance with the Township of Uxbridge Traffic By-law 89-52, it is an offence to stop any vehicle on a highway in such a manner as to interfere with the movement of traffic or the clearing of snow from the highway?

Please make sure you park off any highway or roadway so as to permit snow removal equipment and vehicles to clean the streets during the winter season.

SIDEWALK RESPONSIBILITIES

Snow Removal By-Law 2008-160 states every owner/occupant of any building or vacant lot within the Township of Uxbridge shall clear all snow and ice from any sidewalk(s) adjacent to their property within 24 hours after the accumulation of snow and/or ice.

SNOWMOBILE BY-LAW

Please keep the Township Snowmobile By-Law in mind while operating your motorized snow vehicle this winter season. You are not permitted to ride your snowmobile on any sidewalks, park lands or any other Township property except to cross. Any person found in contravention of this By-Law is liable to a fine.

Permits may be obtained at the Municipal Office at 51 Toronto Street, South or the Fire Station at 17 Bascom Street during normal business hours, Monday to Friday, 8:30 am to 4:30 pm.

NOTE: All existing permits expire December 31, 2011.
