Sidewalk Closed at Brock St. and Toronto St. beside CIBC

Sidewalk expected to reopen in early September

Please be advised that the sidewalk adjacent to the CIBC Bank in downtown Uxbridge will be closed for two weeks. The sidewalk is closed on the north side of Brock St. from Toronto St. to 50 metres west of the intersection. The sidewalk is also closed adjacent to Toronto Street from the corner of Brock Street 15 metres north.

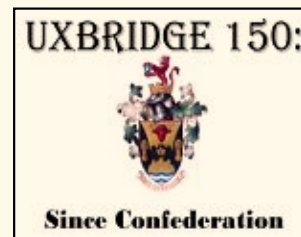
Crews are working to repair a retaining wall adjacent to the CIBC bank, and are preparing the site for the installation of a statue of Lt. Col. Sam Sharpe next year.

The sidewalk may open earlier than planned if the construction schedule is not delayed by weather.

Brookdale Rd Closed for Construction

Culvert completion is anticipated for mid-September.

Construction has begun on the Brookdale Road culvert. Brookdale road will be closed to through traffic for the duration of the work.

Vehicles may enter Brookdale Road from the 7th Concession and access all properties up to and including address #849. Vehicles destined for Foxfire Chase must access Foxfire Chase from Lakeridge Road.

The Trans-Canada Trail also travels on this section of Brookdale Road. Trail users requiring a north-south connection in this vicinity are advised to use Concession 7 to by-pass this section of the trail. The rest of the trail remains open.

This construction has an anticipated completion date in September 2017.
