**Brookdale Rd Closed for Construction**

*Culvert completion is anticipated for mid-September.*

Construction has begun on the Brookdale Road culvert. Brookdale road will be closed to through traffic for the duration of the work.

Vehicles may enter Brookdale Road from the 7<sup>th</sup> Concession and access all properties up to and including address #849. Vehicles destined for Foxfire Chase must access Foxfire Chase from Lakeridge Road.

The Trans-Canada Trail also travels on this section of Brookdale Road. Trail users requiring a north-south connection in this vicinity are advised to use Concession 7 to bypass this section of the trail. The rest of the trail remains open.

This construction has an anticipated completion date in September 2017.
