construction of a new 16,000 sq. ft. Fire Station
in the Township of Uxbridge. The Township of
Uxbridge has established a construction bud-
get for this work at \$3,500,000.00. The Township
of Uxbridge anticipates the design phase to be
completed by April 30, 2013 and the construc-
tion phase to be completed in the fall of 2014.

**THE RENAMING OF THE
KENNEDY HOUSE PROPERTY**

Thank you to all residents that submitted a
name. After our first round of submissions we
believe we need to give a bit more description to
the concept of re-naming the property.

History: In 2008 the Township of Uxbridge pur-
chased the former St. John's Training
School/Kennedy House property from the
Province of Ontario through the Ontario Realty
Corporation.

The Township has always felt that we should
eventually rename the property and we feel the
time is now. A committee was formed in late

2012 to begin this exercise.

The Committee has established a few new
guidelines to help with the renaming of Kennedy
House.

1. The Master Plan below shows what the prop-
erty will eventually look like. We would like to
choose a name that reflects this vision. As you
will note, this property will be the future home for
parks, recreation and cultural activities.

2. While many of the components that will event-
ually be located at this site will have specific
names such as the Rotary Skate Park, these
names will be part of a sponsorship program and
may be subject to change in the long term for
those specific components. The Committee feels
the property name should never change and

should therefore be timeless.

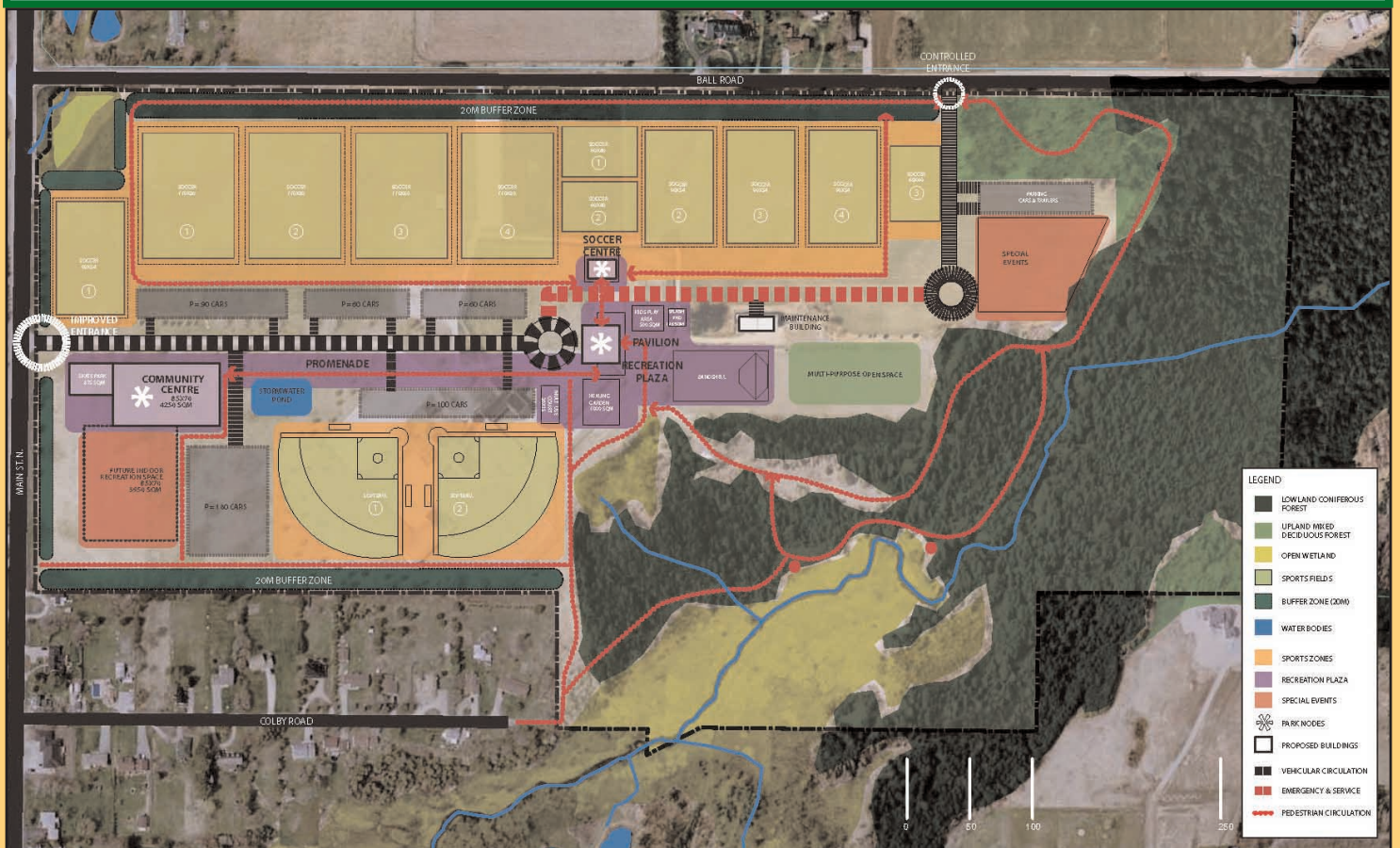
3. No individual's name be considered as a
name for the Park.

4. The name should include Uxbridge.

At present two names have risen to the top:
Uxpark and Uxbridge Common. If you have
