### NOTICE OF THE ADOPTION OF AN AMENDMENT TO THE TOWNSHIP OF UXBRIDGE OFFICIAL PLAN AND NOTICE OF PASSING OF A ZONING BY-LAW THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF UXBRIDGE

**TAKE NOTICE** that the Council of The Corporation of the Township of Uxbridge passed **By-law No. 2017-099** on the 10<sup>th</sup> day of July, 2017, pursuant to Section 17 of the Planning Act, R.S.O. 1990, as amended, to adopt **Amendment No. 59** to the Township of Uxbridge Official Plan and **Zoning By-law No. 2017-100**, pursuant to Section 34 of the Planning Act, R.S.O. 1990, as amended. The Amendments apply to all lands in the Township of Uxbridge.

**AND TAKE NOTICE** that any person or public body who, before the By-laws were passed, made oral submissions at a public meeting or written submissions to Township Council, may appeal to the Ontario Municipal Board in respect of the By-laws by filing with the Clerk of The Corporation of the Township of Uxbridge not later than the **9<sup>th</sup> day of August, 2017**, a notice of appeal setting out the objection to the By-law or By-laws and the reasons in support of the objection, accompanied by a required Ontario Municipal Board fee made payable to the **MINISTER OF FINANCE** in the amount of **\$300.00**.

**PLEASE NOTE** that only individuals, corporations and public bodies may appeal a decision of the municipality to the Ontario Municipal Board. A notice of appeal may not be made by an unincorporated association or group. However, a notice of appeal may be made in the name of an individual who is a member of the association or the group on its behalf.

The proposed Official Plan Amendment is exempt from approval by the Regional Municipality of Durham and the decision of Council is final if a notice of appeal is not received before or on the last day for filing a notice of appeal.

An explanation of the purpose and effect of the Amendments is given below. The complete Official Plan Amendment, Zoning By-law Amendment and background material are available for inspection in the Clerk's Department at the Uxbridge Township Office during regular office hours.

#### PURPOSE AND EFFECT OF THE AMENDMENTS

The purpose of Official Plan Amendment No. 59 is to amend the Official Plan to reflect the directions of the Planning Act, the Provincial Policy Statement, the Growth Plan and the Region of Durham Official Plan in regards to second residential units. It applies to all the lands in the Township. The purpose is to update the current permissions to allow second residential units in detached, semi-detached and rowhouse dwelling units or in ancillary buildings or structures to such dwelling units where such units contains only a single residential unit.

The Zoning By-law Amendment also applies to all lands in the Township of Uxbridge. The purpose of the Zoning By-law Amendment is to permit Two Unit Houses within single-family dwellings, semi-detached dwellings and rowhouse dwellings.
