Notice to Septic Owners: Mandatory Re-Inspections for Lake Simcoe Regulated Properties

If you have a septic system on a property that is located within 100 metres of a river,
stream, lake or pond in the Lake Simcoe watershed, you will have received a letter
from the Township notifying you of mandatory septic inspections.

Current mapping does not indicate exactly where septic systems are located. If you
feel your septic system is not within the 100 metre watercourse boundary, please
contact the Township of Uxbridge Building Services Department to determine if
your septic system should be removed from the inspection list. A property cannot be
removed from the list without approval from the Chief Building Officer, and it is up to
the property owner to contact the Township about this option.

FROM THE TAX OFFICE... 2017 Final Property Tax Bills

All **Residential, Managed Forest and Farmland Final Property Tax Bills** have
been mailed. Payments for these bills are due on the following due dates:

- the **FIRST** Tax Installment is due and payable on **Monday, June 26th, 2017.**
- the **SECOND** Tax Installment is due and payable on **Monday, September 25th, 2017.**

Commercial, Industrial and Multi-Residential Final Property Tax Bills will be
mailed in early June. Payments for these bills are due on the following due dates:

- the **FIRST** Tax Installment is due and payable on **Monday, July 17th, 2017.**
- the **SECOND** Tax Installment is due and payable on **Monday, September 25th, 2017.**

Penalty/interest charges will be applied to Installments not paid by the end of
the month in which the Installment is due, at the rate of 1.25% (or 15% a year) on
the first day of the following month and on the first day of each calendar month
thereafter in which the default continues.

**Failure to receive a Tax Notice does not excuse the taxpayer from
responsibility for payment of taxes nor liability of any penalty or interest due
to late payments. The penalty/interest charges cannot be waived or reduced
by the Tax Department or Council for any reason.**

Tax payments can be made by the following: In person by Interac, Cheque or Cash,
by Mail (Post-dated cheques are accepted), Telephone & Internet banking, drop box,
or at most Financial Institutions.

If you did not receive your 2017 Final Tax Bill, please call the Tax Department at
905-852-9181 Ext. 211.

Taxpayers should retain their 2017 Final Property Tax Bill for reference. If a reprinted
tax bill, receipt or statement is required, a fee of \$12.00 will be charged.
