## ANIMAL SERVICES DOOR TO DOOR LICENCING IN UXBRIDGE

Please be advised that the Animal Services staff will be beginning door to door licencing next week in Uxbridge.

Door to door licencing benefits the Township in the following ways:

- Encourages compliance with the by-law
- Educates the public and promotes responsible pet ownership
- Helps offset costs of medical care for sick and injured domestic and wild animals
- Helps get the animal returned home faster
- Supports feeding, sheltering and safe keeping of stray animals
- Allows staff to contact the dog owner in case of emergency so they can make vital decisions regarding the care of their pet
- Provide 24/7 days a week emergency service

Please leave the sand on the road as there will not be any special pick up of sand left in piles or in pails. It is acceptable to rake any sand that has accumulated on the boulevard into the curb and gutter prior to the sweeping of the street. Any areas that are missed due to parked cars will be redone after all sweeping is complete.

Below is the schedule for sweeping:

1. N/E corner of town - COMPLETED
2. Rural subdivisions and hamlets
3. N/W corner of town
4. S/W corner of town
5. S/E corner of town
6. Town parking lots

(The town portion is divided into 4 areas with Brock & Main Streets as the centre point.)
