2013 Final Property Tax Bills

All 2013 Final Tax Bills have been mailed. Payments for these bills are due on the due date.

**The SECOND Tax Installment is due on  
Wednesday September 25, 2013.**

Please pay promptly to avoid penalty.

Penalty/interest charges will be added to tax installments not paid by the due date at the rate of 1.25% on the first day of each calendar month. Failure to receive a Tax Notice does not excuse the taxpayer from responsibility for payment of taxes nor liability for any penalty or interest due to late payments. The penalty/interest charges cannot be waived or reduced by the Tax Department or Council for any reason.

Tax payments can be made by the following: In person by Interac, by cheque or cash, by mail (post-dated cheques are accepted), telephone & Internet banking, drop box, or at most banks.

If you did not receive your 2013 Final Tax Bill, please call the Tax Department at 905-852-9181, ext. 211.
