The Township of Uxbridge Watershed Advisory Committee and the Energy Conservation Committee are accepting nominations for the Environmental Achievement Award.

This award recognizes any environmental projects that can be related in any way to watershed protection and or restoration, water quality improvements or energy conservation related initiatives, including: maintaining, protecting, or preserving the natural environment; for the restoration of degraded natural environments (e.g. through habitats improvement); for fostering effective communications, sharing knowledge, or exhibiting leadership in helping others improve the natural environment; for creating positive change with respect to the natural environment; or any other significant watershed related improvement; for implementing significant energy conservation measures; for installing renewable energy to minimize the dependency on non-renewable energy; for promoting or educating the public about energy conservation; for innovation in the energy conservation field; or for significantly reducing the carbon footprint of an individual/group/organization.

Nominations are open to any individual, group, club, corporation or organization that reflects and meets the scope of the award as outlined above. Submissions should include a 500 word or less description of the nominee as he/she/they/it relates to the scope of the UWAC & UECC Environmental Award. Pictures, reference letters or other pertinent information can be included with submissions.

Nominations must be submitted no later than November 29th, 2013. The nominations will be reviewed at the December UWAC & UECC meetings, with the successful nominee(s) to be presented with the award at a Council meeting early in 2014.

Notice of Local Residents Meeting Brookdale Road Culvert Replacement, Township of Uxbridge Class Environmental Assessment Study

The Study

The Township of Uxbridge, through their engineering consultant Chisholm, Fleming and Associates, has initiated a Class Environmental Assessment for the proposed culvert replacement on Brookdale Road, about 300 m north of Foxfire Chase, west of Lake Ridge Road (Regional Road 23) and south of Reach Street (Regional Road 8), Township of Uxbridge, Ontario. The existing concrete culvert requires replacement due to structural deterioration in both headwalls, lack of roadside safety and localized road embankment erosion necessitating recurring maintenance.

The Process

This project is planned as a Schedule 'B' project as outlined in the Municipal Engineer's Association (MEA) Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (October 2000, as amended in 2007 & 2011), which is an approved process under the Environmental Assessment Act.

A key component of the study is consultation with interested stakeholders (public and agencies). One Public Information Centre (PIC) was held on May 16, 2013 as part of the consultation process, at which the project and scope was presented; alternative solutions and the evaluation criteria were reviewed; and the environmental impacts and mitigation measures were presented and discussed.

The Local Residents Meeting will be held on Thursday, September 18, 2013 at 7:00 p.m. The venue will be the Seniors Centre at 75 Marietta Street.

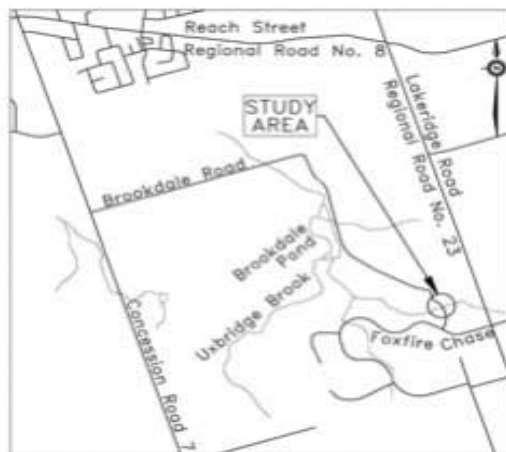
