

**BY-LAW NUMBER 74-53  
OF THE  
CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF UXBRIDGE**

**BEING A BY-LAW A BY-LAW FOR LICENSING,  
REGULATING AND GOVERNING PERSONS WHO GO  
FROM PLACE TO PLACE OR TO A PARTICULAR PLACE  
WITH GOODS, WARES OR MERCHANDISE FOR SALE,  
OR WHO CARRY AND EXPOSE SAMPLES, PATTERNS  
OR SPECIMENS OR ANY GOODS, WARES OR  
MERCHANDISE WHICH IS TO BE DELIVERED IN THE  
MUNICIPALITY AFTERWARDS.**

The Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Township of Uxbridge enacts as follows:

1. THAT from and after the passing of this By-law, all persons who go from place to place or to a particular place within the limits of the Township of Uxbridge with goods, wares or merchandise for sale, or who carry and expose samples, patterns or specimens of any goods, wares or merchandise which is to be delivered in the Township of Uxbridge afterwards, shall take out a license therefor to be known as a Peddler's License and shall pay for such license the license fee of \$1,000.00. No licence shall be issued if the license or the place, as referred to in Section 1 of By-law 74-53, as amended, does not comply with all other applicable Municipal and Regional By-laws including but not limited to the Township's Zoning By-law.
2. A license issued under this By-law shall be valid only from the date of its issue until December 31st of the year of its issue and shall not be transferable.
3. Should a license be issued under this By-law at any time after the 30th of June and prior to the 31st of December in any year, then the license fee to be paid for the broken part of the year shall be \$1,000.00. No licence shall be issued if the license or the place, as referred to in Section 1 of By-law 74-53, as amended, does not comply with all other applicable Municipal and Regional By-laws including but not limited to the Township's Zoning By-law.
4. Every license issued under this By-law shall be renewed by the holder on or before the 15th day of January following the years of its issue.
5. Applications for a license under this By-Law shall be made in writing to the Clerk-Treasurer of the Township of Uxbridge on a form of application approved by the Council of the said Township, and the fee for the license shall be paid to the said Clerk-Treasurer of the Township of Uxbridge.
6. (a) No such license shall be required for hawking, peddling or selling goods, wares or merchandise,
  - (i) to wholesale or retail dealers in similar goods, wares or merchandise, or
  - (ii) if the goods, wares or merchandise are grown, produced or manufactured in Ontario and are hawked, peddled or sold by the grower, producer or manufacturer or his agent or employee having written authority so to do, in the municipality in which the grower, producer or manufacturer resides, or
  - (iii) if the goods, wares or merchandise are grown or produced by a farmer resident in Ontario, who offers for sale or sells only the produce of his own farm, or

- (iv) if the goods, wares or merchandise are hawked, peddled or sold by a person who pays business tax in the municipality, or by his employee, or by his agent, or
  - (v) if the goods, wares or merchandise are hawked, peddled or sold by an agent of the grower, producer or manufacturer, acting on behalf of a dealer who pays business tax in the municipality in respect of premises used for the sale of such goods, wares or merchandise.
7. Such servant or employee referred to in Paragraph 6, Clause (a) sub-clause ii, iv and v, shall exhibit his authority when required so to do by any municipal or peace officer.
  8. In a prosecution for a breach of this By-law the onus of proving that he does not for any of the reasons mentioned in clause (a) Paragraph 6, require to be licensed shall be upon the person charged.
  9. The license shall at all times whilst carrying on his business have his license with him and shall upon demand exhibit it to a municipal or peace officer, and if he fails to do so, shall, unless the same is accounted for satisfactorily, be liable to a penalty of not less than \$1.00 and nor more than \$5.00.
  10. If a peace officer demands the production of a license by any persons to whom the By-law applies and the demand is not complied with, it shall be the duty of the peace officer, and he shall have the power to arrest such person without a warrant and to take him before the nearest Justice of the Peace, there to be dealt with according to law.
  11. Notwithstanding the foregoing, the fee to be paid for a license under this B.1-law, shall in the case of persons who resided continuously within the Township of Uxbridge for at least one yr prior to the application therefor be one-half of the license fee set out in Paragraph 1 of this By-law.
  12. Any person, firm or corporation contravening any of the provisions of this By-law shall be liable on summary conviction to a penalty of not more than \$1,000.00, and costs to be recovered under the provisions of the Ontario Summary Convictions Act. Each day that a violation of this By-law shall constitute a separate offence.
  13. All other By-laws of the Township of Uxbridge or the former amalgamated Municipalities hereto passed, the provisions of which are inconsistent with the provisions of this By-law, are hereby repealed.
