

BY-LAW NUMBER 2015-020

OF

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF UXBRIDGE

BEING A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW 2006-227, BEING A BY-LAW FOR THE LICENSING, REGULATING AND GOVERNING OF TAXICAB DRIVERS, OWNERS AND TAXICAB BROKERS, AND FOR LIMITING THE NUMBER OF TAXICABS

WHEREAS pursuant to the provisions of the Municipal Act, S.O. 2001, a by-law may be passed to provide for the licensing, regulating and governing of Taxicab Drivers, Owners and Taxicab brokers;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Uxbridge considers it advisable to amend By-law 2006-227;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF UXBRIDGE ENACTS THE BY-LAW AS FOLLOWS:

1. THAT the definition of "Limousine", Section 1. I) hereby deleted in its entirety and the following be inserted.

"Limousine" which, without limiting the following, shall include stretched limousines, executive limousines, and van limousines, means a motor vehicle which does not bear any identification other than the Provincial motor vehicle licence, which does not have a taximeter, roof light, or two-way radio (or similar device) and which is kept or used for hire for the conveyance of passengers pursuant to a written contract or invoice solely on an hourly or fixed fee basis with a minimum fee or charge of not less than fifty dollars (50.00) for a single conveyance.

Notwithstanding the foregoing, the term "Limousine" shall never include a Taxicab in respect of which a Licence has been issued to the Owner, under the provisions of this by-law; nor shall it include a bus, an ambulance or a hearse.

2. AND THAT the following be added to Section 12 (Penalty Section) of the Taxi By-law 2006-227 as Section 12.2

12.2 This By-law shall apply to owners and drivers of taxicabs and owners of limousines, engaged in the conveyance of goods or passengers either wholly within the municipality, or from any point within the municipality to any point outside it.

3. AND THAT This amending by-law shall come into force and effect upon passing.

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and finally passed this 9th day of February, 2015.
