Sign By-Law Requirements

The Township of Uxbridge Special Sign By-law regulates all signage and advertising devices, with the goal of maintaining the historical architecture and ambience of the Uxbridge Heritage area. Specifically, it indicates the community's wish for visual coherence predominately through the use of signs, thereby attempting to promote a sense of time and place, and the overall aesthetic character of the township.

- All newly constructed signs, as well as changes to signs located within the Township, must have a permit issued by the Chief Building Official or his/her designate. If you are planning to install or alter a sign, please contact the Township Development Services Department regarding the required provisions.
- Special sign provisions apply to all signage located within the Downtown Heritage Conservation District of Uxbridge.
- A-frame signs within downtown Uxbridge must be no larger than 1.04m² (11 square feet), and must only be displayed in the location identified in the permit, and only during the actual hours of business. All portable signs, including A-frame, T-frame, sandwich boards, and menu boards must be issued a sign permit through the Development Services Department.
- Graphics or text that pertain to and/or advertise the business shall be permitted in windows of the business, but shall not occupy more than 30% of any window. Film/foil that is attached to the window that is blank (containing no graphics/imagery, wording or numbers) shall be permitted, regardless of the amount/percentage of window that it occupies.

Winter Reminders – Uxbridge By-law Services

Overnight Parking

Please be advised that By-law 2013-184 as amended prohibits overnight parking from November 1 until April 1 between the hours of 2 am and 7 am on roadways and Municipal lots within the Township of Uxbridge.

Snow removal obstruction

Did you know that in accordance with the Township of Uxbridge Traffic By-law 2013-184, it is an offence to stop any vehicle on a highway in such a manner as to interfere with the movement of traffic or the clearing of snow from the highway?

Please make sure you park off any highway or roadway so as to permit snow removal equipment and vehicles to clean the streets during the winter season.

Sidewalk Responsibilities

Snow Removal By-Law 2008-160 states every owner/occupant of any building or vacant lot within the Township of Uxbridge shall clear all snow and ice from any sidewalk(s) adjacent to their property within 24 hours after the accumulation of snow and/or ice.

Snowmobile By-law

Please keep the Township Snowmobile By-Law in mind while operating your motorized snow vehicle this winter season. You are not permitted to ride your snowmobile on any sidewalks, park lands or any other Township property except to cross. Any person found in contravention of this By-Law is liable to a fine.
