Township of Uxbridge Accessibility Recognition Awards

To promote greater accessibility and accessibility awareness, the Township of Uxbridge Accessibility Advisory Committee is recognizing and awarding one business and one individual each year to celebrate the commitment to accessibility and holistic inclusion within the Township of Uxbridge.

How to Nominate

To nominate a deserving business or individual for the Township of Uxbridge Accessibility Recognition Awards, you must submit details of their efforts to improve accessibility and/or accessibility awareness, and how the organization and/or individual has gone above and beyond to make accessibility a key factor in the community. You can find the application form and eligibility criteria for these awards at www.town.uxbridge.on.ca. The deadline to submit your nomination form to accessibility@town.uxbridge.on.ca is **October 9, 2017**. Awards will be presented at the Council Meeting on October 23, 2017.

What are the Benefits of the Award?

1. Community recognition for championing leadership in the area of Accessibility.
2. Presentation of a Township of Uxbridge Accessibility Recognition Award that may be displayed on an ongoing basis.
3. A Certificate of Recognition to each Award recipient

5. Inclusion of the details and description of the accessibility initiatives of the business and individual Accessibility Recognition Award winners on the website of the Township of Uxbridge and featured in the Township Page.

FROM THE TAX OFFICE... 2017 Final Property Tax Bills

The Final Tax Installment is due on Monday, September 25th, 2017.

For non-payment of property tax levy on or before the respective due date of each installment, a penalty of 1.25% (or 15% a year) shall be imposed on the first day of each calendar month and thereafter in which default continues.

Failure to receive a Tax Notice does not excuse the taxpayer from responsibility for payment of taxes nor liability of any penalty or interest due to late payments. The penalty/interest charges cannot be waived or reduced by the Tax Department or Council for any reason.

Tax payments can be made by the following: In person by Interac, Cheque or Cash, by Mail (Post-dated cheques are accepted), Drop-box at Town Hall, Telephone & Internet banking, or at most Financial Institutions. Credit cards are not accepted as payment for property taxes.

If you did not receive your 2017 Final Tax Bill, please call the Tax Department at 905-852-9181 Ext. 211.

Taxpayers should retain their 2017 Final Property Tax Bill for reference. If a reprinted tax bill, receipt or statement is required, a fee of \$12.00 will be charged.
